

Treasurer's Report 2018

Considering how the season developed starting with fewer members than last year and matches being cancelled or less rinks being played the final income figure is similar to 2017. The expenditure figure is a lot less than 2017 but was still higher than first anticipated because of the additional costs of new fire doors, green safety hand rails, new dishwasher for the bar and a new web site. The final result is a surplus of £1,973.09

The reserve account shows £20,047.42 and the current account shows £3,063.33 at year end 30th September 2018
