

Treasurer's Report 2019

Considering how the season developed, starting with fewer members than last year, matches being cancelled, less rinks at times being required than originally expected and other issues that we had no control over the club has achieved better results than may have been expected. The final surplus over expenditure was only £801.67, down on last year's figure of £1973.09.

Fortunately, as a committee, we agreed not to proceed with the balustrade. Had this not happened our financial position would not be as it is. We also benefited from a better social events and bar income.

The reserve account shows £18,075.42 and the current account shows £6,184.15 at year end 30th September 2019

I take the opportunity to thank all the other members of the club whose help has enabled me to fulfil my role this last year.
