BRIDPORT BOWLING CLUB COVID-19 STATEMENT

This statement is to be read in conjunction with the robust procedure formulated to enable members to bowl safely.

It must be noted that Government/Bowls England are still recommending that those in the 70+ age group should remain home. All members are responsible for their own health and if anyone in the upper age group wishes to bowl, it is their decision and not the responsibility of Bridport Bowling Club. It may be that guidelines will be relaxed as time passes, but as of today's date, that it not the case.

Bridport Bowling Club has provided wet wipes, hand sanitizer, anti-bacterial soap and information posters to enable members to bowl safely. Hand-washing with soap and water remains the most effective cleanser but hand sanitizers are a convenient extra layer of hygiene. Although the Club has supplied all necessary hygiene aids, we would ask that all members, where possible, have their own supply of wipes and hand gel and rubber gloves if preferred. (Hand sanitizer is available at the Spar Shop, West Bay). Funds into Bridport Bowling Club this season and the remainder of 2020 are limited, with necessary outgoings depleting funds. Therefore, whilst we wish to provide all necessary aids, we would ask members to support the club by using their own.

Should risk factors increase, the Committee reserve the right to shut the Club at short notice.
